Saline Community Fair Ambassador Responsibilities:

Saline Community Fair Ambassadors are responsible for representing and promoting the Saline Community Fair at community events and assisting with fair activities. A calendar of events giving an idea of the planned activities will be distributed after selection has been made. We recognize that not every ambassador will be available for every event.

Activities May Include:

Assisting with various activities and shows during the fair (times would not conflict with school days, 2023 dates of fair activities are August 30th – September 3rd. These activities may include passing out awards at animal shows, the school club showcase, livestock auction, Ag Olympics contest between Saline School buildings, Ladies Day, Heroes' Day, talent show, Farmer for a Day exhibit, Taste of Ag program, Car and Tractor Show, the bike drawing, and perhaps at entertainment events. Ambassadors will also be introduced during an activity at the fair, most likely on Wednesday evening, August 30th, during the school club showcase. Other duties may include assisting the fair at community events such as the Saline Boo Bash table, the Christmas parade, Saline Summerfest and Easter Egg Hunt at the Saline Recreation Center where the fair often has a table. If desired, the ambassadors are welcome to attend monthly fair board meetings and provide input to the board.
