To qualify for this community leadership experience, eligible candidates must:

- Be in grades 9-12 as of September 2023
- Open to anyone in the Saline School District, as well as any eligible young persons who resides within a 15-mile radius of the Washtenaw Farm Council Grounds, 5055 Ann Arbor-Saline Road, Ann Arbor, MI 48103
- Selection will be based on the application, resume and interview
- Up to 4 ambassadors will be selected in a given year.
- **Ambassadors will receive a \$200 scholarship, name badge and/or polo shirt.**

Activities may include the following:

- Assisting with various activities and shows during the fair – Farmer for a Day exhibits, Taste of Ag Program, Car and Talent Show, and bike drawing
- Passing out awards at animal shows, school club showcase, livestock auction, AG Olympics, Ladies Day, Heroes Day, and talent show
- Assisting the fair at community events such as Saline Boo Bash Table, Christmas parade, Saline Summerfest, and at the Easter Egg Hunt
- Also invited to attend monthly fair board meetings and provide input to the board.
