- Each contestant must BAKE TWO ALIKE PIES, one for the contest and one for the auction at 6:00 p.m. on Friday of the fair.
- Only one entry may be made.
- Fruit pies only, such as apple, berry, peach, etc. One or two crust.
****no cream pies or pies that require refrigeration****
- All entries must be accompanied by 2 copies of a list of ingredients. Contestants name MUST NOT be on the list.
- ALL ENTRIES BECOME PROPERTY OF THE SALINE COMMUNITY FAIR
- Entries do not include gate admission to the Fair.
- All pies should be in 9 inch disposable containers
- Hot pies will NOT be accepted.

Judging

- Judging will begin at 1:00 p.m.
- Winners will be announced during the Ladies' Day Program
- Awards will be as follows:
- Grand Champion Pie \$75.00, Reserve Grand Champion Pie - $\$ 50.00$
- $3^{\text {rd }}$ Place Pie $\$ 25.00,4^{\text {th }}$ Place Pie $-\$ 20.00,5^{\text {th }}$ Place Pie $\$ 15.00,6^{\text {th }}$ Place Pie $\$ 10.00$
- Premium checks will be mailed.
