2025 Saline Fair - General Vendor Information

Welcome to the 2025 Saline Community Fair, our 89th.

Dates: Wednesday, August 27, 2025 to Sunday, August 31, 2025. Monday, September 1 (Labor Day) will be rides only.

Set up times/dates: Monday, August 25, from 1:00 PM to 6:00 PM. Tuesday, August 26, from 1:00 PM to 6:00 PM. Wednesday, August 27, from 8:00 AM and 10:00 AM.

Take down times/dates: You may start take down your booth at 9:30 PM and exit the building at 10:00 PM on Sunday, August 31. The building must be cleaned out by 11:00 AM on Monday, September 1.

Merchant Building Hours: 10:00 AM to 10:00 PM Wednesday to Saturday. 11:00 AM to 10:00 PM on Sunday.

Merchants need to be in their building at least 5 hours a day, which includes the opening hours of the opening day and the closing hours of the closing day, unless other arrangements are made.

Carnival Dates: Wednesday, August 27 to Monday, September 1, 2025.

Rates for vendors for the entire week of the fair:

Inside booth rates. 8 x 10 for \$150.00 - 8 X 20 for \$275.00

Outside booth rates: Start at \$150.00 to \$200.00 for a 10 x 10 ft. space. Contact us for rates on larger spaces.

Electric Rates: 110 volts for \$25.00 for inside and outside—220 volts outside only for \$75.00.

Liability Insurance Fair Rider: \$60.00 (Merchants Building Only)

Table Rates: \$10.00 for 6 or 8 ft.

Booth Deposit: \$25.00 will hold your spot. Full Payment due by August 1, 2025.

Fair Passes: Each booth and outdoor space will receive 2 entry passes. Additional passes are available at the rate of \$30.00 a pass.

Parking pass: Each booth and outdoor space will receive one parking pass for our front parking area. Additional parking passes cannot be purchased, but additional free parking is available in the lot next to the fairgrounds.

Merchant Building Contest: We will once again be holding a contest to choose the grand champion booth. Three winners will be chosen: \$100.00 and a banner for first place, \$50.00 and a ribbon for second, and \$25.00 and a ribbon for third. The colors for the building drapery will be royal blue and red. We encourage vendors to give away free items, if possible, to draw visitors to their booth. Please note - no inflated balloons as they wreak havoc on the ceiling fans.

Building raffle: We encourage booths to have items to raffle at the fair. This is a great way to get contact information. The winners of our raffles will be chosen at the end of the fair on Sunday night at 8:00 PM

Ladies Day: The organizers are requesting any merchant or vendor that can donate 1 special item or small items (200) that could be placed in the Ladies Day giveaway bags. All ladies that attend the program are given a bag from local merchants to take home. This is another way to get your name out there.

Contract Information: If interested in becoming a vendor at the 2025 Saline Community Fair, please download, complete and sign the contract, return a contract to the address below. (Contracts and other forms are available at our website <u>www.salinefair.org</u> or by mail.)

Liability Insurance: All merchants and vendors inside and out must have liability insurance to participate in the fair. We must have a copy of your liability insurance by the start of the fair in order to set up. If liability insurance is needed, fill out the rider form and return it with your contract. *(The fee for the rider is \$60.00)*

If you cannot participate in this year's fair, please let us know as soon as possible so we do not hold a space for you and we can plan out the building and outside spaces.

If the fair must be canceled due to the state of emergency, we will work with you to return your deposit or hold it for a future fair. If you have questions, please call us.

All current and existing COVID-19 rules and regulations must be followed while on the fair grounds by all merchants and vendors inside and out (if they are in place at fair time).
